CONTEXT

The world's largest FOWT event will be held on September 7 and 8, 2020 in Marseille at the Palais du Pharo.

Given the health risk associated with COVID 19, exceptional measures will be applied to the event to guarantee exhibitors, visitors and service providers the best possible health security.

The organizing committee is closely monitoring the situation in relation to the Regional Health Agency. Depending on the evolution of the pandemic in France, Europe and around the world, the measures that will be definitively applied to the event are still likely to evolve. The FOWT health protocol will be updated regularly and available on the website.

BEFORE THE CONFERENCE

- A “Covid-19” questionnaire to be completed 48 hours in advance, online, will be sent to each participant registered for the face-to-face edition in order to verify that the participant does not present symptoms of the disease (fever, cough, sneezing , fatigue, loss of smell etc.). In case of proven symptoms, we ask the participant to opt for online monitoring of the event and not to show up at the Palais du Pharo. We also recommend the participant to get closer to his doctor if necessary. Failure to complete the questionnaire will amount to denying access to the participant, who can still complete it on site in paper format on September 7.
- The health protocol in place at the event will be returned a few days before the event.

UPON YOUR ARRIVAL

- Access control: verification of the ticket and filling the questionnaire "Covid-19."
- An agent will take your temperature with a laser thermometer. Beyond 38 °, you will not be able to access the event.
- Distance (1 meter between each person) during the queue
- Hand washing at the entrance to the site using a hydroalcoholic gel dispenser
- Wearing a mask is compulsory upon entry

DURING THE EVENT

- General rule: The minimum distance of "1 meter" between each person will be the rule on the event. Wearing a mask will be mandatory throughout the event. Signage will remind you of the need to wear a mask when the distance of 1 meter cannot be respected between two people. Participants will find several hydroalcoholic gel points. Distancing rules will also be applied during social events (breaks, lunch, cocktail dinner).
- Stands: Exhibitors must ensure compliance with health instructions on their stand, in particular the density of attendance at their stand.
- Reception: Reception hostesses and security guards will also wear the mask.



CORONAVIRUS GUIDANCE



HYDROALCOHOLIC GEL

Gel dispensers will be set up at the main accesses to the event, an agent will ensure that people apply gel to their hands before entering the event.

Self-service gel diffusers will also be set up in the aisles and restaurant areas. The toilets will also allow hand washing.

DOCUMENTS

All magazines, newspapers, catalogs on paper media affected must be taken away by the person who touched it.



HYGIENE

The toilets will be sized according to the reception capacity and the rules of distancing. They will be regularly cleaned, the frequency of cleaning having been increased. The door handles will also be cleaned.

CATERING

A detailed catering protocol will be communicated shortly. The “1 m” distance rule will be applied for all people. Individual containers are provided. The catering service provider has also set up a Covid-19 protocol with these teams. If time permits, breaks and catering will take place outside.
